News from the Executive Board

iNTACS e.V. annual meeting with Executive Board and Advisory Board members

Würzburg, Germany - On January 10th, iNTACS held its annually meeting, bringing together the Executive Board members and Advisory Board members. The meeting serves as a platform for the exchange of ideas and insights on the latest developments in the working groups.

During the meeting, the Advisory Board members provide valuable feedback on the strategies and initiatives, while the Executive Board presents updates on the progress of ongoing projects and future plans. This meeting focused on the new training concept for Automotive SPICE® PAM 4.0 and the introduction of the new training "Process Expert". Besides that, it was discussed that the rules for assessor certification and renewal were updated to cover the new concept.

The 2024 iNTACS e.V. virtual member convention will take place on September 4th, 2024 (1:00pm - 3:00pm CEST). Our members will receive the invitation and agenda by email and letter. Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency PAM published on our website

There is a new PAM available on our website! The Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA®) published its process assessment model (see https://intacs.info/spice-center) for software development according to JERG-0-049 (see https://sma.jaxa.jp/techdoc_en.html). The JAXA®-PAM is an ISO/IEC 33004 conformant and ISO/IEC 33020 compliant assessment model. iNTACS has confirmed this in a technical review.

Creation and use of assessment "certificates"

As a non-profit organization, iNTACS e.V. does not interfere with the business activities of its partner companies. This also applies to the creation of assessment "certificates" for Automotive SPICE® assessments. The creation of assessment "certificates" by assessors or the organization carrying out the assessment is the responsibility of the creator and is possible in general. In this context, however, we would like to point out that the use of the intacs logo and trademark on assessment "certificates" is not permitted. The use of the assessor's signature with intacs certification number is possible. Please note the regulations and trademarks of the VDA QMC®.

Update of the intacs® training concept

In coordination with its partners in VDA®, iNTACS e.V. has updated the training concept, which will be applied from the start of the training courses for Automotive SPICE® 4.0. The certification levels for assessors will not be changed. The Process Expert training will be offered independently with a scope on Technical Development. First Automotive SPICE® 4.0 upgrade training successfully completed!

iNTACS e.V. has successfully conducted the first Upgrade Pilot Training for Automotive SPICE® 4.0 from the 28th to 29th of February 2024. Certified trainers from accredited training companies took part in the two-day event. It was the first opportunity to present the content and discuss and exchange ideas with international Instructors of the community. The feedback will be processed as part of a review and an updated version of the training material will be produced. Colleagues from VDA® AK13 also took part in this review. News from our Working Groups

Status of iNTACS Working Group "WG Training Development"

New intacs® training architecture extended with "Combined Lane"

As already published several months ago, iNTACS will change the training architecture for certified SPICE assessors this year, together with the updated trainings for Automotive SPICE® 4.0.

The introduction of the new intacs[®] certified Expert training for Automotive SPICE[®] will not only support assessors to understand the model, but also practitioners who have to ensure the conformity of internal processes and projects to the PAM.

After intensive discussions with stakeholders from VDA, OEMs and suppliers, iNTACS decided to extend the new architecture with an alternative path for becoming a Provisional Assessor. Besides the standard path of completing the Expert training for becoming familiar with the PAM, then collecting first experiences, and applying the model in projects and organizations, before attending the second part in the Provisional Assessor training, there is now also the chance to become a Provisional Assessor in "one step" without missing important information.

The so-called "Combined Lane" allows the attendance of a seven-day training spread out over two weeks, that contains the material of both trainings, Expert and Provisional Assessor, with an exercise between the two parts and only one exam at the end of the training. Of course, such a long training course in one session is a greater challenge for prospective assessors in terms of concentration and receptiveness. Therefore, the "Standard Lane" with sufficient time between the parts is also highly recommended.

Because of these recent updates, the initially planned release of the new training architecture in July 2024 must be postponed to October 1st, 2024.




Figure 1: New iNTACS training architecture

To simplify and accelerate this model's application in assessments we decided to merge the former System-V and Component-V into just one common Mechanics-V. In addition, SPICE for Mechanical Engineering was aligned with the conceptional changes introduced with Automotive SPICE® 4.0.

In June 2022, we finalized and released the SPICE for IT-Services PAM version 4.0. Meanwhile we successfully completed a small number of pilot trainings with different groups of interested people as well as a few assessments.

As of today, we are happy to announce the release of the combined SPICE for IT-Services Process Expert/Provisional Assessor Training.

Currently we are working on a Competent Assessor training course. This will establish SPICE for IT Services as an independent certification pathway.

An updated version of the PAM and the Competent Assessor training is planned to be ready for review by the end of 2024.
